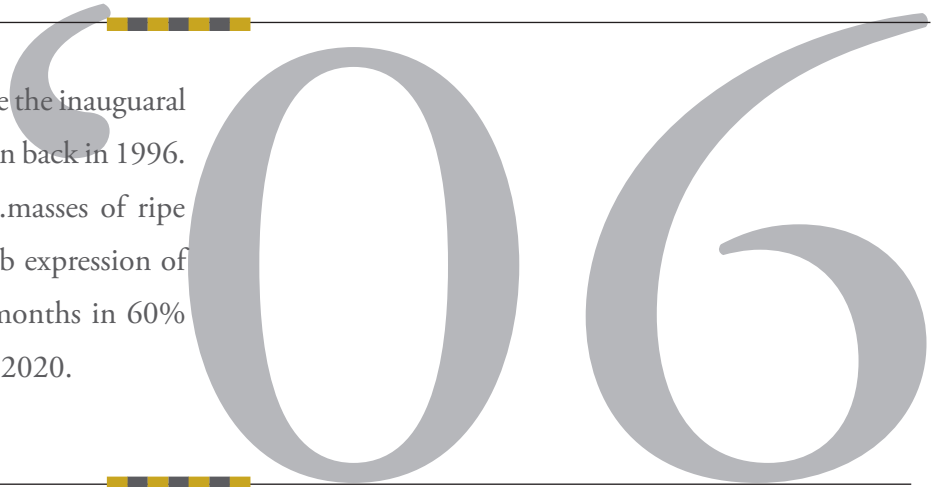


2006 CABERNET SAUVIGNON OAKVILLE
