Full of bright cherry and raspberry fruit with a touch of oak, this bottling delivers distinctive Pinot Noir character with smooth as silk texture. Our first Pinot Noir sourced from outside Santa Lucia Highlands, this wonderfully effusive wine is from Sunset Vineyard in Carneros. Sunset Vineyard, owned by veteran growers the Garvey family, is located in the southwest portion of Napa Valley. Carneros is known for its long, warm growing season that allows the grapes to mature slowly and evenly.
