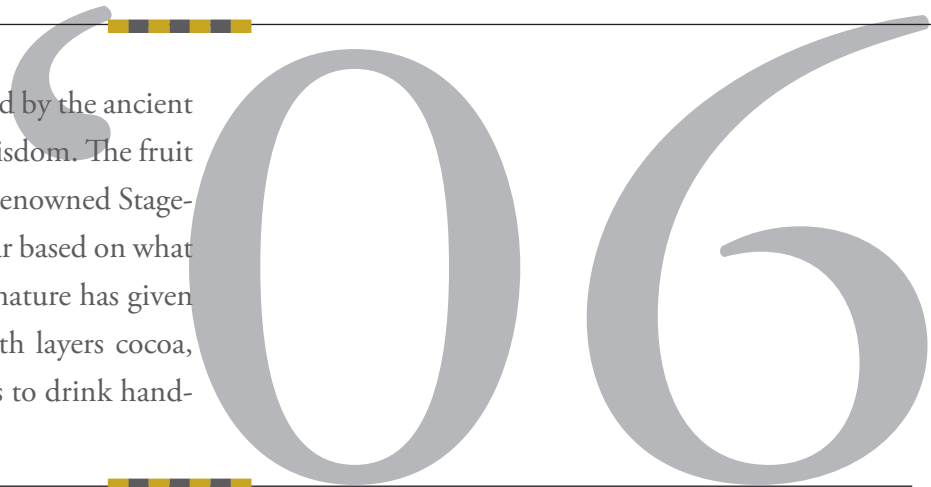




THE ORACLE

The Oracle is a Bordeaux-style blend inspired by the ancient Greek Oracle, the center of prophecy and wisdom. The fruit for this wine is sourced from Napa Valley's renowned Stagecoach Vineyard. The blend changes each year based on what we believe makes the best wine from what nature has given us. This is an elegant, full-bodied wine with layers cocoa, spicy oak and lush blackberry that promises to drink hand-somely for at least a decade.
